

MARCH INCIDENT DISTRIBUTION PROFILE


Incidents by Day of the Week for Date Range Start Date: 03/01/2020 | End Date: 03/31/2020

EVFD STATUS REPORT

PANDEMIC OPERATIONAL ADAPTATIONS & ADJUSTMENTS

In the spirit of protecting EVFD members by minimizing the opportunity to expose or be exposed, we are limiting entry to Fire Station 40. This action will be for two-weeks at which time the District will reassess. (situation assessed 10 April; situation reassessment 05 May)

What This Means to our Members:

- a) Continue to respond to 41 or 40 for all multi-unit incidents (status quo). Do not enter a fire station for any reason other to respond to an incident.
- b) If you need to check your analog mailbox or pick up a paycheck: call ahead, ring the door bell, and a person will bag and deliver your mailbox contents. Do not enter the fire station!
- c) The EVFD Firefighter Academy is suspended during the two-week period. (Except target solution programs.)
- d) Tuesday drills are suspended during the two-week period. (Look for *Target Solutions* programs and Zoom classes coming during April.)
- e) To add or change your timesheet, call your data into the Shift Captain, he will enter your numbers for you.
- f) No PTP shift work for two-weeks.
- g) No fire station standby.
- h) To respond an apparatus, enter the apparatus bay; avoid entering the living or office area of the fire station. If you need to use a restroom use the men or women restrooms closest to the apparatus bay.
- i) Before leaving the fire station make sure all touch services have been wiped with a sanitizing wipe (including apparatus!)
- Response and training participation requirements (three-month average) are suspended during the two-week period.
- k) By Governor proclamation, we are not allowed to have any public meetings whatsoever. (We are working on 'Zoom' as virtual meeting solution.)
- 1) 12% Road Grade Request Update: Refer to accompanying information PDF.
- m) <u>2020 FIREFIGHTER ACADEMY</u>: The 2020 Firefighter Academy continues to progress nicely with the original eight dedicated recruits; *Target Solutions* continues to receive positive user ratings and remains a valid alternative for weekday evening classroom sessions.
- n) <u>STATION 42</u>: Thanks to great weather, construction is proceeding quickly. Weekly construction meetings provide informative updates, proposed changes are discussed and decisions made.
